SOCIETIES ACT

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is “The Comox Valley Minor Hockey Association”
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a) To promote amateur ice hockey and other athletic sports;
 - b) To provide its members with opportunities and training for self-development, leadership and sportsmanship;
 - c) To stimulate inter-club competition and competition with other communities
 - d) For furtherance of the above purposes to provide facilities and equipment and to maintain the same.
3. The Society shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits shall be used for promoting its purposes.
4. In the event of winding up or dissolution of the society, any funds of the society remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, shall be given or transferred to such organizations promoting the same objectives of this society, as may be determined by the members of this society at the time of winding up or dissolution, and if effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provisions, then such funds shall be given or transferred to some other organization; provided that such organization referred to in this paragraph shall be a charitable organization, a charitable corporation, or a charitable trust recognized by the Canada Revenue Agency as being qualified as such under the provisions of the “Income Tax Act” of Canada from time to time in effect.
5. Sections 3 and 4 are unalterable in accordance with Section 22 of the Societies Act.
