U15 Report for the 2021-2022 Season Submitted by Luisa Perry, Division Manager

The U15 season was an overall success. We had 5 teams of 14-15 players. Each team had a head coach and 2-3 assistant coaches, one or two team managers and some safeties. Teams were created using a balancing approach, with two weeks of evaluation games to form initial "teams" and an additional two weeks of balancing games before teams were finalized. Game play was very close for most games, with only one or two goals difference between teams.

Four of the teams were able to attend away tournaments, the fifth team's planned away tournament having fallen in January when tournaments were cancelled due to Covid. We had a successful home tournament, with 7 out of town teams attending from Victoria, Sooke, Kerry Park, Nanaimo, Port Hardy, Powell River and Campbell River. The division participated in multiple exhibition games with Powell River — both in Comox and in Powell River and multiple exhibition games and shared practice times with Campbell River during their strike.
