Five Priorities for the association:

- 2) Two parts to the association competitive and recreation that are both important.
- 3) Volunteers are our capital recognition for volunteers is important.
- 4) Respect in the association is paramount.
- 5) Hockey in the CVMHA has to be fun, it has to be uplifting, it has to be challenging and it has to help participants to reach whatever potential they would like to realize from their choice to belong.

Work together to manage complaints by our members – listen and be empathetic to any concerns.

Would like to ensure that the Ways and Means committee occurs – 2nd Vice to manage this committee.

It is important that there is a Comox Valley way of playing hockey – universal way to meet an end result. Allan, Cam, Dallas, Luisa and Tish to create a basic framework around the "Way We Play" CVMHA curriculum for the next meeting.

A database is needed to record statistics to support discussions with parents about what we have been working on with their players in terms of skill development.

Important for players to stay at home at long as possible. Is there an education program that CVMHA could be working with to create a hockey program.

First shift program pricing went up to \$299 and can have up to 45 participants in the winter program.

Penticton AGM is booked for June.

Working with BC Hockey, as we are a Tier 2 association that has been approved to be Tier 1.

Creating new HCR for all players and building team snap.

June 15 is when registration will open for CVMHA.

Ice Allocator: Had the ice meeting in April. Friday morning ice was taken by Ringette. We are considered a private group that can be bumped by other competing groups wanting ice.

There is a committee that is being formed around the potential new arena – will need a person to sit on the committee – Trevor to sit on that committee.

August 15 is the deadline to provide the CVRD with what programs will be using the ice during the ice slot (Allan, Cam, Dallas, Andrew and Melissa to come up with a plan around ice).

NIDES program has ice on Monday and Wednesday.

CVRD requires that a first aid person be in the arena as well as the safety. They will be running an 8 hour first aid course. This is a facility requirement.

Tournaments are all set – Melissa to send the tournament list to Simon.

Coach coordinator: Coaches meeting to gather feedback information is occurring May 24.

Evaluations have been sent out to support team formation next season.

Station based practice plans were used all year and sent out to coaches.

Manager meeting will be held May 25 at 6:30.

Female development meeting will also occur.

All female players will register with CVMHA.

Coaches for rep are now ratified.
